Student's Report (Abigail Moran):

President's Report (Lana Luscombe):

Director's Report (Ryan Rowley):

Mr. Rowley introduced Mariah Tietjen, a student teacher from Drake that will be involved with the Hoover Band until Spring Break. The Jazz Band went to State at Woodward-Granger and scored higher than last year. The Orlando band trip meeting was cancelled due to bad weather so will be held after the February 21 concert at Hoover. He sent out concert information but not everyone got it so he will resend. He is focused on assessments right now, particularly on rhythm, and will be on Infinite Campus soon.

Old Business:

Orlando trip... those who did fundraiser and are going to Orlando should get a check from their part. Kathy said still having issue with SNAP. Marching uniforms have been cleaned. Beaver Cleaners were sold to Park Ave Cleaners so slight discrepancy on original cost but Lana is working it out.

Several bands have signed up for Jazz Fest, 3A and 4A. The Jazz Fest Bible has been a tremendous help to organize this year's event. 54 bands have signed up which is more than ever. Mr. Rowley asked Kathy how many Jazz Fest shirts were ordered last year. The names of the bands will be on the back.

New Business:

Mr. Rowley brought up a new software program called Charms. The old one is Destiny which only tracked inventory and was limited. Charms is an extensive program that has a music library, calendar, can collect forms for all sorts of things, has phone messaging and texting, can do financials, inventory, multiple emails, enter all student information, upload financial documents like the treasurer's report, manage Alumni, etc. This program will track all of the student information regarding personal instrument(s), shirt size, personal phone numbers, emails class schedules, awards, etc.

The cost is \$395/year and Dan voted to accept and Lana seconded the motion to approve the yearly expense of Charms.
